COURSES OF STUDY, LEVELS I and II

1. ITALIAN STUDENTS, COMMUNITY ED EXTRA-COMMUNITY STUDENTS REGULARLY RESIDING IN ITALY

The University fees include a flat fee and a variable fee (all-inclusive fees), calculated based on the students' income. The course of study he or she is enrolled in, and the number of enrollments with respect to the normal length of the degree programme.

*The initial academic year for purposes of determining the number of enrolments for each student with respect to the normal length of the course of study is the academic year of enrolment at university as an active student *Italian decimal system*

In order to obtain the calculation of the fees considering the ISEE value:

- 1) Students with incomes produced in Italy must obtain the ISEE 2020 for the right to study and, from July 1 to October 23 must login in their Reserved Area <https://studentionline.unipv.it/Home.do> (segreteria - benefici) and authorize the University for the acquisition of the ISEE datas contained in the declaration issued by INPS at the moment of the ISEE request. The ISEE will be not acquired if there are "non compliant" issues on it.

ATTENTION: students who want to submit the EDISU request for benefits (scholarships, college rooms, canteen...) must follow the same procedure as described above.

- 2) Students with income and assets produced and possessed abroad must bring the official certification, legally validated in Italy, to the Tax Office desk (via Ferrata 5, Pavia) during the opening times. These documents must show:

- Family incomes for year 2019
- The members of the nuclear family, also indicating any family members with serious disabilities.
- Square meters of the family residence
- The amount of movable assets of the student's nuclear family as of december 31, 2019

STUDENTS WHO APPLY FOR BENEFITS FROM THE EDISU (ENTE REGIONALE PER IL DIRITTO ALLO STUDIO, REGIONAL AUTHORITY FOR THE RIGHT TO STUDY) LINKED TO THE RIGHT TO STUDY (FOR EXAMPLE, SCHOLARSHIPS, ENTRANCE IN UNIVERSITY RESIDENCE HALLS (COLLEGI), STUDENT CAFETERIAS,...) WILL BE REQUIRED ONLY TO PRESENT AN APPLICATION BASED ON THE PROCEDURE AND TERMS OF THE EDISU (<http://www.edisu.pv.it/index.php?page=diritto-allo-studio>). EDISU WILL TRANSMIT TO THE UNIVERSITY THE CONSENT GIVEN FOR ACQUIRING ISEE DATA FROM INPS AND, WITHOUT ANY ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS, THE UNIVERSITY FEE DUE WILL BE CALCULATED.

- 3) Students with mixed incomes must follow the rules described at paragraph 1) and 2).
- 4) Stateless students or political refugees with proper and valid documentation about their situation will be compared to Italian students and must follow the rules described at paragraph 1). In case of inability of producing the ISEE documents, after giving the authorization, they will be able to submit the ordinary ISEE directly writing to ufficiotasse@unipv.it.
- 5) For students coming from particularly poor countries, as provided by art. 13 comma 5 of DPCM 9 April

2001, which list is defined every year by a Ministry Decree, the evaluation of the economic situation is provided on the basis of the documentation described in [art. 13 comma 5 of the same DPCM](#).

Are automatically put in the maximum brackets students who:

- Don't authorize the University to extract the University ISEE datas;
- Have authorized the extraction of an ISEE that is not for University, or that has "non compliant" issues;
- Are not able to produce the documentation as for paragraphs 2), 3), 4) e 5).

The student's fees are divided into FOUR installments:

First Installment (composition)

Students enrolling in the various courses of study will pay the first instalment of € 156.00. The deadline for payment coincides with the enrolment deadline.

Students enrolling in successive years to the first year (or to the first year as repeating students) will pay a first instalment that includes the fixed fee of € 156.00 and an amount corresponding to 20% of the all-inclusive fees based on the Isee presented for the previous academic year.

The deadline for all students enrolled in successive years to the first year is **September 25, 2020**.

Second and Third installments (composition)

The second installment will be equal to 30% and 40% of the total amount due based on ISEE for the right to study or on the maximum contribution level for students who do not ask for contribution based on the family incomes. All students including first year students, will have to pay the second installment within **December 4, 2020** and the third installment within **February 12, 2021**.

Fourth installment (composition)

The fourth installment is equal to the difference between the yearly full fee and the amounts paid in the first and second installments. All students will have to pay the third installment within **April 16, 2021**.

STATUS AS AN INDEPENDENT STUDENT

A student is considered independent and eligible to use his or her ISEE as a single component of a nuclear family only if both of the following conditions subsist:

- registry office records show residency for at least two years preceding the date of October 25 outside the residence of the family of origin and in a property not belonging to a member of the nuclear family of origin;
- Income derived exclusively from work as an employee, or similar work which is not for a family member, of not less than € 6,500.00. This amount has to have been declared on a tax return. The amount is subject to change based on decisions by the regional council in Lombardy, which can change the income requirements for calculating the indicators needed to be eligible for financial assistance.

In the event that, after checks by the Tax Office, it is found that the student does not meet the eligibility requirements to be considered an "independent student", sanctions will be applied under Article 15 of the Regulation of University Fees.

2. NON-EU STUDENTS WHO WANT TO APPLY FOR A FIXED CONTRIBUTION OF FEES (*Flat rate*)

International Students (those with non-EU citizenship and a visa/permit of stay for study reason) who did not request for any benefits, service or financial help to the University and/or to EDISU will be placed in one of the fee brackets showed in Table B (page 10) according to the country and to the course of study. The flat rate bracket will be established at the moment of enrollment, and will remain the same for a number of years equal to the normal length of the course of study. Students admitted to years after the first the flat rate will remain the same for a number of years equal to the amount of years left, plus one.

DOUBLE CITIZENSHIP: in case of double citizenship, with one of them being comunitarian, the EU citizenship prevails, and students must follow the rules as for EU citizens. Therefore, the flat rate system is not available in this case.

3. EXEMPTIONS AND REFUNDS

Any refund will be made exclusively through a bank transfer to the bank account linked to the University Card (*Carta Ateneo+*). In the event the recipient of the refund does not possess this card, he or she must provide

the Iban code in the Reserved Area (*Area Riservata*) for the account (on his/her name alone or as a joint account) to be credited. The right to credits earned until May 2021 will be paid by July 2021.

Exemptions and refunds regarding the regional tax:

1. disabled individuals with a disability ≥ 66 ;
2. foreign students who have a scholarship from the Italian Government as part of the development cooperation programme and cultural and scientific intergovernmental agreements
3. eligible non-beneficiaries possessing the proper requirements to compete for regional EDISU scholarships
4. students that lose the status of conditional enrollment in a Master's degree, as provided by art. 7 of the Students' Regulation.

Exempted or reimbursed regarding the all-inclusive university fees:

1. disabled individuals with a disability $\geq 66\%$ and students with certified disability, according to art. 3, paragraph 1, Law 104/1992
2. foreign students who have a scholarship from the Italian Government as part of the development cooperation programme and cultural and scientific intergovernmental agreements
3. students with regional EDISU scholarships or those possessing the proper requirements to compete for one
4. students enrolled for the first time at an Italian university in a degree programme or a single-cycle Master's programme and who have completed high school with the maximum mark of 100/100. The same rule shall apply to students who have completed high school abroad under the condition that the certification of validity of the diploma or an equivalent document show that the maximum mark was attained;
5. students enrolled for fewer years or a total number of years (including all the enrollment years of the university career) equal to the normal length of the degree programme plus one year and with an ISEE \leq € 23,000.00;
6. students who have graduated within the official period of the single-cycle Master's programmes will be 100% reimbursed for the all-inclusive fees of their last year, under the condition their overall university course load contains a number of enrolments equal to and not greater than those for the normal length of the course of study they were enrolled in;
7. students who have graduated within the official period of the second-cycle degree programmes will be 100% reimbursed for the all-inclusive fees of their last year of the programme, on condition they were enrolled for no more than three years in the first level degree programme and no more than two for the subsequent second level programme. Reimbursements will not be granted if even one of the following conditions pertains:
 - a. there is an academic gap between the three-year degree and enrolment in the Master's degree programme;
 - b. the student has had a shortening in his or her academic career (admission directly to the second or subsequent years of study) even at one of the two degree levels;
 - c. if the student has already benefitted from this type of exemption (for example, in the case of having completed a second Master's degree);
8. students enrolled in a course of the Superior Studies University Institute (IUSS) of Pavia that are winner of a free accommodation in one of the University Colleges;
9. permanent employees of Pavia University may request an exemption of up to five academic years for each first-cycle course of study, for a maximum of seven years, including the second-cycle degree or single-cycle degrees. In all cases, enrolment in a course of study must be determined to be of interest to the university and coherent with growth projects related to the applicant's area of work.
10. enrolled students who are children of at least one permanent employee in the technical-administrative category with an ISEE less than € 25,000.00 can receive a 50% exemption for university fees. The exemption can be used for a maximum of one year more than the number of years in the normal length of the course of study; the student in question must have earned at least 30 CFU (course credits) during the previous year.
11. students whose foreign degree is recognized as equivalent will receive a 50% exemption for their all-inclusive fees;

12. students who passed all compulsory exams and activities in their study plan within 30 April of the academic year of last enrollment and who will obtain the degree within the following September 30 (December 15 for the degree courses of the health professions) can request the exemption of 75 % of the all-inclusive fee due for the following academic year. In case the registration of the last exams is later than the above dates, the student will have to pay the full fee due for the degree course. To access this benefit, students must not enroll to the new academic year according to the usual deadlines, but in the period **between March 1, 2021 and the deadline of the payment of the fourth installment..** Those students, before paying the first installment, will have to hand in a form for recalculation of their fee to their course desk.
13. "Bonus fratelli" ("Siblings Bonus"). In the case where there are siblings enrolled at the University of Pavia in the same academic year in either level I or II courses of study, a € 300.00 reduction for the all-inclusive fees will be granted, on condition the nuclear family's ISEE is less than or equal to € 45,000.00. Each sibling is eligible for the "bonus" under the following conditions:
- the siblings must be enrolled in Pavia University in the same academic year; if, during the academic year, one of the two siblings graduates or decides to transfer, withdraw, etc. from Pavia University, the student who remains enrolled can benefit from the bonus for that academic year;
 - the siblings must belong to the nuclear family as certified for purposes of calculating the ISEE (in the case of independent students or those who represent a nuclear family in their own right, the bonus is not applicable).

The discount is applied to the amount owed for the all-inclusive fees and cannot exceed the amount of such fees; therefore, in the case a student who, under existing regulations, owes no all-inclusive fees or an amount less than € 300.00, the discount will equal the amount owed the university.

Also totally or partially exempted from payment of the all-inclusive fees are those who are included in particular regulated cases through conventions stipulated with Pavia University or through decisions of the Management Board; the purpose in this case is to provide an incentive for certain courses of study.

Any fee reimbursement is permitted in cases (mentioned above) that come under Article 12 of the Regolamento sulla Contribuzione (Regulation of Fees), published in the university webpage under the section 'Fees'

4. PART TIME STUDENTS ENROLLMENT

Pavia University allows students in particular circumstances (working students, disabled students, etc.) to enroll part-time. The regulations for this type of enrolment are contained in the following specific [Regulations](#).

5. CONVERSION OF DIPLOMAS INTO UNIVERSITY DEGREES

Students intending to convert their university diploma, earned based on the existing didactic regulations for degrees as spelled out in Article 3, subsection 1 of D.M. 509/99 and subsequent changes and additions, are required to pay, in addition to the flat fees, an amount based on the percentages in the table below. The same rule is valid for students in possession of diplomas from the Scuole Dirette a Fini Speciali (Special Objective Schools) that require the conversion.
